




Four early readers with charming illustrations and an emphasis on relationships and fun.





The Curious Cat Spy Club



The middle grade years can be a time of social awkwardness, but also a time of self-discovery, when kindness shines extra bright. Four books to enjoy during these transitional years.




Confessions from the Principal's Kid

However, when her best friend starts to deal with bullying, she has to figure out: when is it right to stay silent, and when is it right to speak up? A thought provoking, realistic story.






Lemons


Unfortunately, he hoards shoes, not treasure, But the shoes prove more interesting than they first seem. A delightful fantasy story from one of the most popular authors today.





Unteachables


