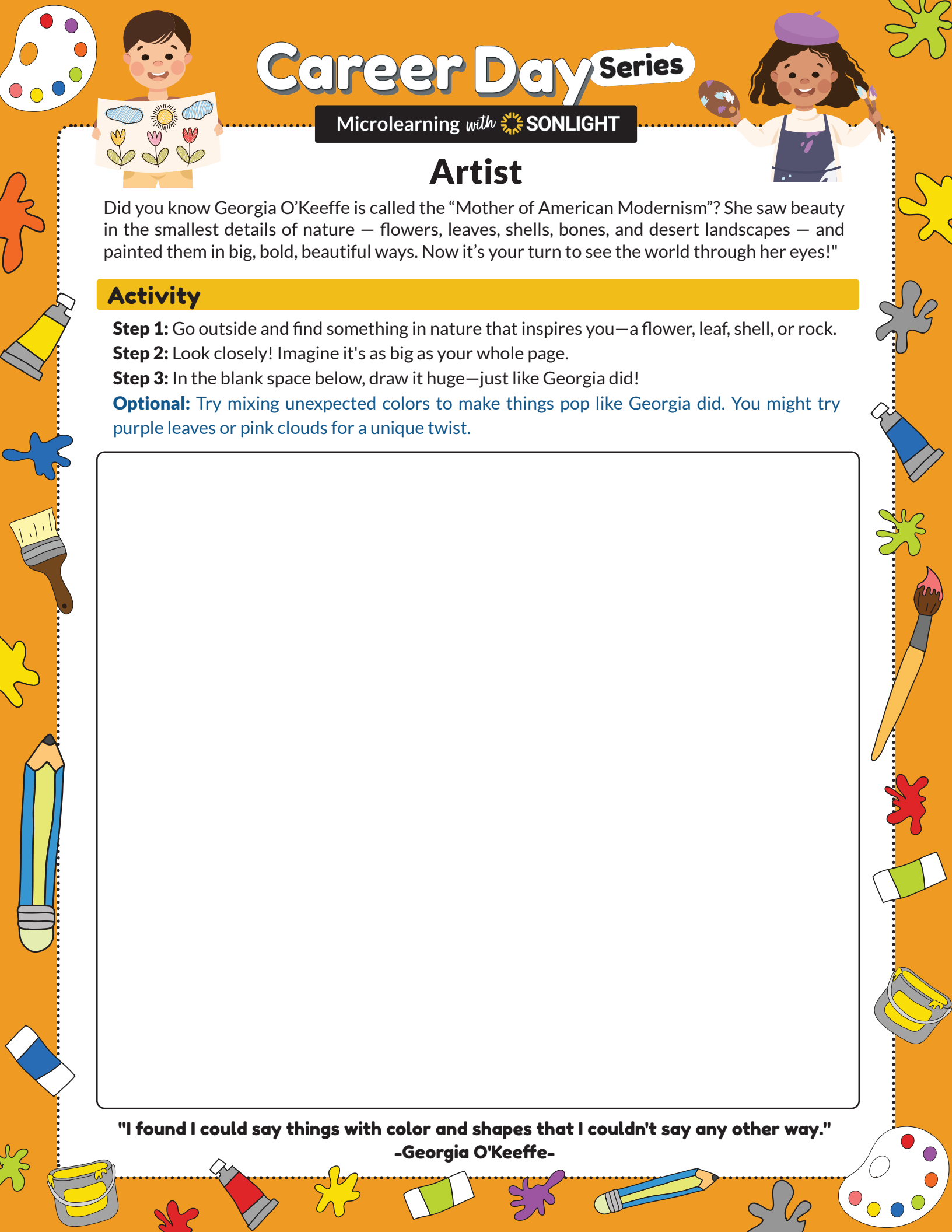

Activity
