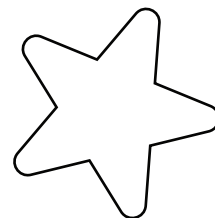
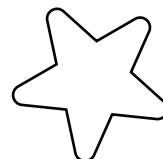


Catch a Shooting Star!



You'll Need:

- Printable meteor/star cutout (provided)
- 1 sheet of black paper (acts as the night sky)
- Crayons or white gel pens (for stars)
- Strips of tissue paper, ribbon, or foil (for meteor tail)
- Glue stick or tape
- Scissors
- Optional: glitter, stickers, star cutouts

Instructions:

1. Decorate Your Night Sky:

Use white crayons, gel pens, or stickers to add stars, planets, or a moon to your black paper sky.

2. Design Your Meteor:

Color the meteor/star cutout.

Add a glowing trail using colored paper strips, ribbon, or foil glued to the back.

3. Assemble the Scene:

Glue your meteor to the black night sky sheet.

Make it look like it's flying across space with a sparkly trail!

4. Make it 3D (Optional):

Bend the meteor slightly and glue just the edges to the background for a pop-up effect.

Or punch a hole and hang the finished sky on a wall or window.
