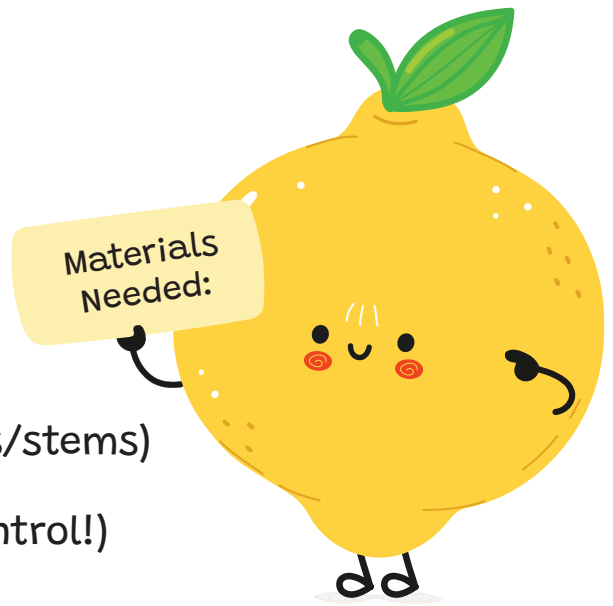


# Lemon Printing Art

Create bright and cheerful lemon-themed art using real lemons as stamps.

- 1–2 lemons (cut in half)
- Yellow paint (tempera or washable)
- Paper plates or trays (for paint)
- White or colored paper
- Green markers or crayons (for leaves/stems)
- Paper towels or smocks (for mess control!)



## Instructions:

### Prep the Lemons:

Cut lemons in half (an adult should do this).

Blot the cut side with a paper towel to remove excess juice.

### Set Up the Paint:

Pour yellow paint onto a paper plate or tray.

Spread evenly so it's not too thick.

### Stamp Time!

Dip the flat side of the lemon half lightly into the paint.

Press the lemon firmly onto the paper to make a print.

Repeat to create a pattern, lemon bunches, or a lemon tree!

### Add Details:

Use a green crayon or marker to draw leaves, vines, or a tree trunk.

Kids can also turn the lemon prints into smiley faces, suns, or characters.

### Let It Dry:

Allow artwork to dry before displaying.
