

Christmas Tree Card Craft

A simple craft with few supplies, this Christmas card makes a wonderful project for children to create and share with family and friends. Feel free to add your own style by using different colored card stock, fun stickers, and a personalized message inside.

SUPPLIES:

- Neutral color card stock (light brown/ beige) – 1 sheet
- Holiday pattern card stock 1 sheet
- Light green card stock 1 sheet
- Assorted color mini pom-poms
- Scissors, ruler, pencil, fine-point paint pen/marker, glue stick/hot glue gun
- Optional: yellow felt, holiday stickers

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut a rectangle 6" x 8" from the neutral color card stock. Fold in half so you have a 6" x 4" card.
- 2. Cut a square 4" x 4" from the holiday pattern card stock. This will become the Christmas tree for the front of the card.
- 3. Fold the card stock square in half and sketch a half-tree shape along the folded edge. Make sure that the top of your tree shape meets the top corner of the folded edge. Perfection is not the goal here!
- 4. Cut out the tree shape and open.
- 5. Cut a 4" x 1.5" strip from the light green card stock. This will be the Merry Christmas banner at the bottom of the card.
- 6. Now it's time to put all the pieces of the card together. Using either a glue stick or hot glue gun (with supervision), affix the tree and banner to the card. Top your tree with a yellow pom-pom or cut a star shape out of the optional yellow felt.
- 7. It's your turn to be creative! Decorate with colored pom-poms and holiday stickers. A budding artist should feel free to embellish with hand-drawn decorations. Use a simple "Merry Christmas" for the banner at the bottom of the card or craft your own greeting. Pen a personalized message inside to finish your project.
