

Reindeer Gift Bag

A fun and simple craft to help get your family involved in a gift-giving spirit this year. A few simple supplies, some basic cutting and gluing, and you have a creative way to transport homemade goodies to family and friends.

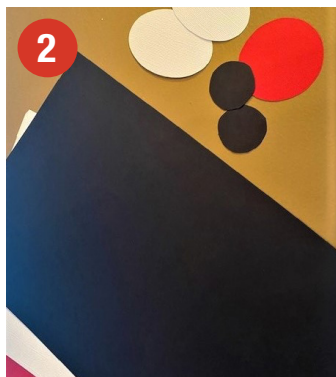
SUPPLIES:

- Brown paper lunch bag (6 lb size)
- 1 sheet each of white, black, and red cardstock
- Template (below) for nose, eyes, and eyeballs
- Scissors, ruler, and glue dots/glue stick/glue gun

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print off the included templates for the nose, eyes, and eyeballs.
2. Cut one nose from the red cardstock, two eyes from the white cardstock, and two eyeballs from the black cardstock.
3. Open the lunch bag and fold over the top 3”.
4. Glue the black eyeballs to the eyes.
5. Attach the eyes to the top of the bag, extending an inch or so over the top. Attach the nose to the bottom of the folder over portion so that it extends an inch or so.

SUGGESTIONS: attach a Velcro dot or piece of two-sided tape to the back of the nose so you can secure the bag flap closed. Using colored pens or pencils, write a Christmas greeting on the front of the bag.
